1. Authority

- The event will be a Club sprint held under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A., the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd. (CAMS), the Speed Event Standing Regulations, , these Supplementary Regulations, the Passenger in Vehicle Guidelines, the 2012 P.C.V. Standing Competition Regulations, and any Further Regulations which may be issued. The event will be conducted under and in accordance with the CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found at www.cams.com.au
- The event will be a multi car sprint conducted at Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit over 4.45km in an anti-clockwise direction.

2. Entries

- Must be lodged with the event Secretary. Faxed entries with credit card payment will be accepted to fax number 9391 5911 online entries via the
 website.
- In accordance with NCR83, the competition committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without explanation.
- A maximum of 90 entries plus 20 entrée class will be accepted and in order of receipt on a correctly completed entry form.
- Entry fee is as stated on the entry form
- Entries open on 15th December 2011 and close at 9:00am Tuesday 31 January 2011. Refer to entry form regarding late entries.
- All competitors must have registered to get their Cars scrutinised by 08.45 hrs on the day of the sprint.
- Entry to the event is conditional upon assisting on the day as and when requested by the organisers.
- Competitors must produce their current Porsche Club Victoria membership card and current CAMS L2S licence (or superior), CAMS Vehicle Logbook (if
 issued) and Competition Record (if issued) at registration.

3. Vehicles

- Cars presented to the scrutineer not ready for competition will be denied entry to the event.
- CAMS Logbooks (if issued) must be presented at scrutiny.
- Cars must comply with Schedules A and B of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport & P.C.V. 2012 Competition rules.
- Tyres must be roadworthy and comply with Schedule E of the current CAMS Manual & the P.C.V. 2012 competition rules.
- Open, M1 & M2 Class cars must comply with the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, Schedule E Wheel and Tyres, Clause 3 Wet Weather Tyres
- Competition cars may be selected for Dyno and/or Weight testing and/or Eligibility assessment under the 2012 PCV standing rules.
- Competition cars must be fitted with a Dorian transponder, as timing will be by electronic means only. Entrants in Entrée Class only will not be timed
 and dorians are not required.
- Note: Maximum Noise not to exceed 75db(A) as measured by 30-Metre drive by test on equipment provided by circuit.

4. Apparel

- Open 1, M1, & M2 Class competitors must wear driving suits in accordance with the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, Schedule D Apparel
 Clause 2.1 Race. All other competitors must wear neck to ankle to wrist non-flammable clothing.
- Helmets must carry a standard as listed in Schedule D of the 2011 CAMS Manual.

5. Event

- Cars will be released onto the circuit alternately at 5-15 second intervals. Vehicles must run in allocated Group order. A maximum of 20 cars will be
 permitted on the circuit at any one time.
- Drivers are not to refuel in pit lane, starting or dummy grids
- Drivers must obey flag and board signals. The Facts to be Judged shall be in accordance with the Speed Event Standing Regulations.
- Protests, if any, must be submitted in writing to the Stewards or Clerk of Course in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.
- Results posted on the day are provisional only and are subject to further checking.
- Vehicles will not be permitted on the circuit after 4.30pm and must have vacated the complex by 5.00pm.
- During driver familiarisation only entered drivers and experienced competitors will be permitted in vehicles as passengers, subject to bone-fide instructors signing the appropriate indemnity form. All occupants must have at least Level 2S licences. Vehicles are to be driven at 80% of competition pace. Passengers will not be permitted in vehicles during any part of the Supersprint. All passengers must sign the relevant declaration.
- Awards for the event will be as per the 2012 P.C.V. Standing Competition Rules.
- The Porsche Club of Victoria reserves the right to take appropriate legal action, and to recover damages.

6. General

- In accordance with NCR59, the Promoter reserves the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the event at any time.
- Insurances will be provided in accordance with Appendix I of the CAMS Manual.
- During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Anti-Doping Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s). The CAMS Anti Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and as amended from time to time, is recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti Doping Policy will take precedence.
- Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the CAMS Manual and may not be available at the event.
