SPONSORSHIP, PRIZES & RULES

The Porsche Club of Victoria is pleased to announce that we will reinstate the Participant of the Year Award for 2022.

This award is available to all PCV members and encourages member participation in a variety of PCV events. Our good friends at Traction Tyre & Suspension Centre have kindly agreed to sponsor the First Prize, continuing our long association with them that began back in 2007. Our thanks go to Andrew McCathie and the Team at Traction Tyre & Suspension Centre for their longstanding support for the Club.

Sponsors & Prizes

First Prize - Traction Tyre & Suspension Centre: Yokohama tyres of the winner's choice (subject to availability), from Traction Tyre & Suspension Centre, including fitting and balancing, to the value of **\$2,000** (prize to be claimed by 1 March 2024).

Second Prize – Items of the winner's choice from the Porsche Driver's Selection, online shop or in person at any Victorian Porsche Centre to the value of **\$400**.

Third Prize – 12 months PCV membership renewal to the value of **\$200**.

Participant of the Year Award

The competition will be open to all PCV primary financial members for the 2022 calendar year, plus Life members and Associate members (excluding General Committee members holding office during the 2021 - 2022 Club year). Members who are part of family membership only are not eligible.

Award of Points

Members who fully participate in events conducted as part of the 2022 Calendar will be awarded 1 point, including:

- Competitors & Entrée entrants in Motorsport Events
- Marshals, Officials and volunteers in Motorsport Events.
- Participants in Social Events
- Participants in Register Events.
- Participants in the 2022 Annual Dinner.

Note: Complimentary events such as Club Nights or Workshop Tours do not earn points.

Included Events

For 2022, eligible events include Events from 1st January 2022 to the 31 December 2022.

Full Participation

Whether a participant has fully participated in an event may be determined by the Committee in its sole discretion, and the decision of the Committee will be final. As a guideline in relation to runs, a member will have fully participated in an event if the participant has paid for the event, attended the starting point (unless prevented by illness or mechanical breakdown advised promptly to the organiser of the run), completed the run, and attended the function forming part of the event.

Awarding of Prizes

After 31st December 2022, the eligible members who have accrued the three highest points totals for participation across all events (as indicated by PCV records) will be declared the winner respectively of the First Prize, Second Prize and Third Prizes.

Should several eligible members accrue equal points resulting in a tie for any of the prizes, that tied prize shall be shared between those members having equal points sufficient to win that prize.

Announcement of Prizes

The prize winners will be announced at the first Club Night in 2023. Vouchers for the prizes will be presented to the prize winners, or mailed to prize winners if they are not in attendance. Winners' names will be published in Porsche Parade.

Guarantee & Disclaimer

In accepting the prizes, winners release and indemnify the PCV and the General Committee and its members from and against all actions, proceedings, claims and demands which may be brought by any person in respect of the use of the said prizes by the winners.

Disputes

Any dispute concerning the rules, conduct or results of the 2022 Participant of the Year Award, must be addressed in writing to the Committee of the Porsche Club of Victoria Inc. The Committee's decisions concerning such disputes will be final and binding on all members.
