Members Update

SERVICE FOR RICHARD OLDHAM

Saturday 31st October commencing at 10:00am
St Peters Anglican Church, Brighton (corner Were & Moffat Sts, Melway 76 E2)

We provide this further information for those PCV Members who are planning to attend the funeral of Richard Oldham and participate in the parade of Porsches.

It is intended that the parade of Porsches follow the hearse up Were Street towards Hampton Street. However, turning into Hampton Street could prove difficult on Saturday morning so the parade will (almost certainly) leave the hearse before Hampton Street and turn left up Champion Street, then proceed to Peacock Street turning left into Peacock Street and left again into Roslyn Street. At Were Street turn right to get back to St Peters.

The hearse, followed by the parade, will leave St Peters fairly shortly after the casket has exited the church. Marshalling of all Porsches may be difficult and it is suggested that drivers only proceed to their cars and join the parade. The cars will be returning to St Peters after only a few minutes and passengers can be picked up then or drivers can linger longer at the church.

When going to Royal Brighton Yacht Club it would be wise to get to The Esplanade via Dendy Street, right turns at South Road are prohibited.

Contrary to an earlier advice, RBYC is located at Melway 67 C10, not 76 C10.
