Australian Historic Motor Festival at Winton Raceway 30th September/1st October 2006

As you will see from the detailed information described in attachments to this flyer this event is one of the big ones in the calendar. Last year over 200 cars took part and this year, being our Club's 30th Anniversary year the Festival organisers have invited the Porsche Club of Victoria to participate in this event in several special ways:-

Porsche and the Porsche Club Victoria will be the Feature Marque for the Festival

There will be a Static Display area of Porsche cars for PCV members attending the meeting and 2 free passes will be given to each car who pre-registers for the display

PCV members will have the opportunity of participating in the Grand Parade (over 170 cars last year)

The Club has been offered a race of our own – a special Regularity event for Porsche cars only to be held on both days. More on this later.

While it is essentially an historic cars event and most entries will be from cars older than say 1980, the organisers are keen to see as many Porsches as possible at the Festival and they welcome participation from Porsche cars of all ages and models. We are particularly keen to encourage cars that are either technically or historically unique to participate so if you know someone whose car fits that description encourage him or do him in or both.

There will be an opportunity to practice on Friday 29th September and on the Saturday morning and the plan is to get two runs in on Saturday afternoon and three on Sunday.

Those wishing to participate in the Regularity event must have a current AASA Club License or the CAMS equivalent, L2S.

Those of you wishing to compete in the Festival's "racing" events please complete the entry process independently though it would be helpful if you could tell us what you are doing.
