- The event will be conducted in accordance with Motorsport Australia Return to Race strategy, PCV Covid-19 Event and Venue Plan, and Porsche Club of Victoria Covid-19 Operating Plan.
- Entries will be accepted in order of receipt unless otherwise specified
- The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent/ guardian.
- Event organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.
- Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

**ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES**

Any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Anti-Doping Policy and/or the Motorsport Australia Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the Motorsport Australia website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a Motorsport Australia 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a Motorsport Australia Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the Motorsport Australia Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

## **SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**

The following additional Regulations form part of the Supplementary Regulations:

### **Government requirements**

Federal, State and Territory and Local Public Health Authority guidelines will be followed in the running of this event.

### **Monitoring**

All attendees (including Competitors, Officials, and support crew (note limit on permitted numbers) are required to preregister for the event. All are encouraged to use the COVIDSafe App. A list of registered competitors, support crew and officials will be provided to venue security staff. Only authorised attendees will be allowed access to the venue. No spectators will be permitted.

### **Hygiene practices**

Appropriate signage will be placed throughout the venue. Reminder Public Address announcements will be made reminding to practice appropriate hygiene. Hand sanitisers, wipes and spray will be available throughout the venue. A COVID-19 Event checker will monitor practices throughout the day.

### **Venue entry and exit**

Entry and Exit to the event will be via the main security point. A list of authorised competitors, support crew and officials will be provided to the venue security staff. Only authorised attendees will be allowed access to the venue.

### **Social distancing**

Under no circumstances are competitors to enter the control tower or another competitors garage. All competitors, officials and volunteers must demonstrate social distancing requirements and remain 1.5m apart.

### **Documentation and Licence checking**

All documentation and licence checking will be conducted remotely prior to the event. In person Licence check may not be available on the day of the event.

## **Briefings/Event communication**

All pre-event briefings will be conducted online. Communication during the event will be processed via PA system and electronic means. Contactless Dorian pick up. If required, Officials will be positioned behind clear protective screen.

## **Scrutiny**

Scrutiny arrangements will comply with Motorsport Australia Return to Race protocols.

## **Equipment**

Any equipment will be appropriately cleaned prior to use. Gloves will be worn. Appropriate signage regarding hygiene practices and social distancing will be displayed.

## **Paddock**

Competitors will be directed to a nominated a parking area in the paddock. All competitors, officials and volunteers must demonstrate social distancing requirements and remain 1.5m apart. When using public amenities, they must comply to the maximum crowd allowance as display.

## **Judicial matters**

If required Clerk of Course or Assistant Clerk of Course and Steward to meet with competitor outside at base of control tower. 1.5m social distancing to be maintained. No competitors are permitted to enter the control tower.

## **Medics and Safety/Recovery**

Maximum 2 per vehicle, Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to be used. Will remain outside vehicles until called.

## **Trackside Officials**

Flag marshals – maximum 1 or 2 per post maintaining minimum 1.5m distance.

Dummy Grid - all drivers to remain in car,

No persons apart from designated Officials allowed on the dummy grid area. PPE to be used and 1.5m social distancing to be maintained.

## **Competitors and Team personnel**

No passenger rides will be allowed. Nominated (and registered) support crew (maximum one (1) per car must stay within allotted space. Minimum 1.5m social distancing to be maintained.

## **Race Control/Tower**

The following officials **only** will have access to the control tower: Clerk of Course, Assistant Clerk of Course, Steward. All officials to be seated min 1.5m apart (4m<sup>2</sup>). Two (2) Timing staff to be in separate room with 1.5m spacing. Control tower cleaned pre-event by venue management and wiped down at lunchtime. Signage at door to confirm maximum number of people allowed to be displayed.

## **Entries**

To allow time for additional administration, entries will close earlier than usual, on **8 July 2020**.
