1. Authority

- 1.1 This Event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), the Speed Event Standing Regulations, the CAMS Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) Policy, the Porsche Club of Victoria procedures, the 2018 Porsche Club of Victoria Standing Competition Rules, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations and Instructions issued for the Event.
- 1.2 This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S, CAMS Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au
- 1.3 Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

3. The Event

The Event will be a Multi-Car and **Multi-Club Super Sprint** Event to be conducted at Broadford Motorcycle Complex on 28th October 2018.

4. Description of the Proposed Competition

The Event will be run in a clockwise direction subject to Track Licence conditions.

Broadford Event Guidelines:

- Vehicles must a run in allocated order.
- Maximum group size will be 10 cars with a minimum release interval of no less than 5 seconds.
- Competitive overtaking only if the car being overtaken has signalled and then only between Turn 12 exit and 50m prior to Turn 1.
- There will be no overtaking under brakes.
- The Event will be run in a clockwise direction.
- Track entry will be via the Pit Lane behind the Timing Tower.
- Drivers will be let onto the track with the maximum practical separation. Sessions will run for eight (8) minutes or such other period as determined by the Clerk of the Course. Once shown the chequered flag, proceed at non-race pace and exit the track via the off ramp at turn 10.
- A vehicle striking a cone between Turn 5 and Turn 12 exit will incur a five (5) second addition to the Competitor's time for a lap in which a Competitor strikes a cone.
- The Clerk of the Course may, in the absolute discretion of the Clerk of the Course, impose a five (5) second addition to the Competitor's time for a lap in which a Competitor overtakes in a designated non-overtaking area.
- Passengers will not be permitted in vehicles during any part of the Super Sprint.
- Classes as per Article 7 of these Supplementary Regulations.

11. Judges of Fact

The Clerk of the Course shall be the Judge of Facts in relation to the Event.

12. Awards

This Event will have awards in accordance with the 2018 Porsche Club of Victoria Standing Competition Rules.

13. Protests

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

14. Abandonment

Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the Event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

15.PASSENGERS

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy and the Porsche Club of Victoria procedures.

(a) A briefing must be attended by each Driver and Passenger (and guardians of each Passenger if Passenger is under 18 years of age) conducted by the Clerk of the Course prior to the MSPRA commencing.

(b) Passengers MUST:

- i.wear the same protective gear as a Driver
- ii.Be fitted and restrained as required for each Automobile with consideration for their physical attributes
- iii.Complete a Passenger Ride Entry Form and Disclaimer
- iv.Drivers must fill out a Passenger Ride Entry Form to ride as a Passenger.
- v.Be at least 12 years of age

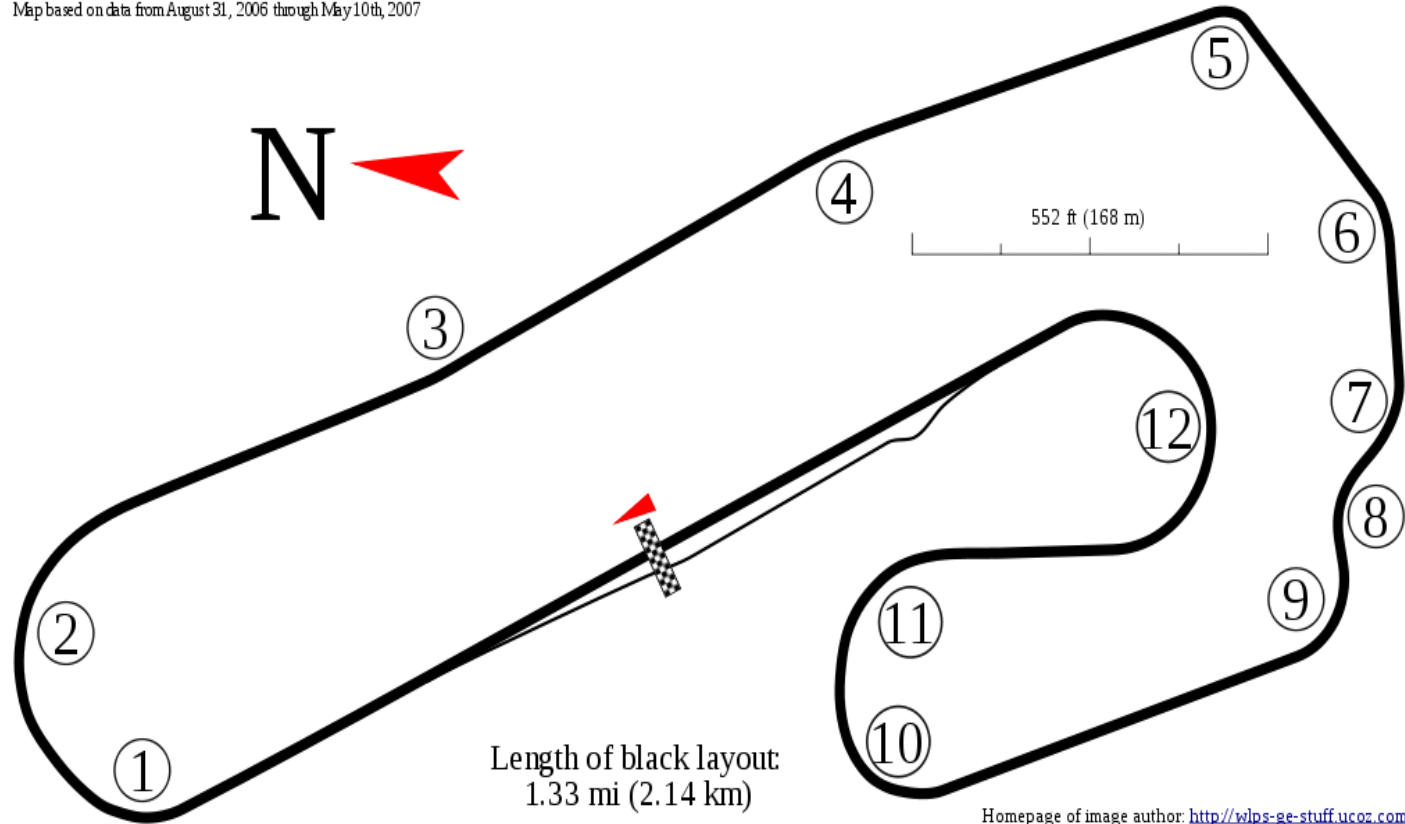
(c) Vehicles and Apparel used must pass Scrutiny.

Vehicles shall only carry one Passenger at a time.

16.Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
