Please read the Supplementary Regulations carefully and make sure you understand the changes from a normal sprint day. The paramount objective is to share our passion for speed in a safe environment. Only cars that have two seats in them and can carry passengers will be accepted.

EACH ENTRANT MUST SHOW THE SCRUTINEER TWO CAMS APPROVED CRASH HELMETS FOR USE ON THE DAY. No helmets are available for hire from the Club but can be hired through Garner's Hire Bikes in North Melbourne Ph 9326 8676.

Drivers please note the 75 dB(A) noise limit.

Make sure your CAMS licence is current and you are a financial member of the Club.

Please note the only entry/exit to the Sandown Racecourse is via the Princes Highway/Dandenong Road overpass. The overpass gate will be open from 6.15am to 5.30pm. The gate to the pits (5E) will be open from 6.45am. Proceed to Registration and Scrutineering in front of the garages in pit lane. Melways Map Reference 80 A9.

1. Authority

The event will be a non-competitive, non-timed club supersprint held under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A., the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd. (CAMS), the Speed Event Standing Regulations, the CAMS Passenger in Vehicle Guidelines, the 2008 P.C.V. Standing Competition Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations, and any Further Regulations which may be issued.
The Promoter of the event is the Porsche Club of Victoria, PO Box 911 Kew VIC 3101

2. Entries

- * **Faxed entries with Credit card payment will be accepted to fax number 9391 5911.**
- * The competition committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without explanation.
- * No entries shall be accepted from under 18 year old competitors.
- * A maximum of 90 entries will be accepted and in order of receipt on a correctly completed entry form.
- * Entry fee is as stated on the entry form
- * Entries open and close at the times/dates as stated on the entry form.
- * **All drivers must have registered by 08.45 hrs for vehicle Scrutiny on the day of the event.**
- * **Entry to the event is conditional upon assisting on the day as and when requested by the organisers.**
- * Drivers must produce a current Civil **Drivers Licence** issued by a State or Territory their **club membership card** and a current **CAMS licence** a minimum level of **L2S, at registration.**
- * Insurance will be provided to licence holders in accordance with Appendix I of the CAMS Manual.

3. Vehicles

- * Cars presented for Scrutiny and found not ready for participation will be denied entry to the event.
- * Cars must comply with Section 6, Schedules A and B of the CAMS 2008 Manual of Motor Sport.
- * Tyres must be roadworthy and comply with P.C.V. 2008 competition rules.
- * **Open, M1 & M2 Class cars must comply with the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, Schedule E - Wheel and Tyres, Clause 3 - Wet Weather Tyres**
- * Maximum Noise not to exceed 75db (A) as measured by 30-Metre drive by test on equipment provided by circuit.
- * All vehicles must be road registered or capable of being road registered.

4. Apparel

- * **Open Class, M1, M2 Drivers must wear driving suits in accordance with CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, Schedule D - Apparel Clause 3 - Clothing (i) Races.** All other drivers and all passengers must wear neck to ankle and neck to wrist non-flammable clothing. PCV strongly recommend all participants to wear Driving Suits.
- * Helmets worn by drivers & all passengers must carry a standard as listed in Schedule D of the 2008 CAMS Manual.

5. Event / Safety.

- * A maximum of 20 cars are permitted on the circuit at any one time.
- * Presidents Day is deemed to be a Social Day and all drivers must limit themselves to 80% of competition speeds.
- * Any driver who has an off or is deemed to be driving in excess of 80% of competition speeds maybe disqualified from further track driving on the day, by the Clerk of Course.
- * Drivers must hold a current L2S licence or higher and be aged over 18.
- * **No car will be allowed on the track unless they have a passenger.**
- * **All passengers must sign a CAMS indemnity form before they enter a car to go out on the track.**
- * Drivers must be familiar with and obey flag and board signals in use during the event.
- * Drivers must run in numerical order unless otherwise instructed by an official.
- * The consumption of Alcohol by drivers and officials before the end of final session at 4.30 pm is strictly forbidden. During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any time during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24-hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.
- * Vehicles will not be permitted on the circuit after 4.30pm. and must have vacated the complex by 6pm
- * The promoter reserves the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR59.
- * All drivers must attend the drivers briefing Scheduled for 09.15 hrs. and any further briefing called throughout the day.



GUIDELINES FOR PASSENGERS IN VEHICLES

Passengers are only permitted in vehicles provided a written request by the event organisers has been received by the State Office together with a permit application. When the above-mentioned permit is issued the following conditions **must be** complied with.

1. No more than one car per 300m may be on the track at once. (The State Manager authorising the activity has determined this number).
2. All passengers, including those who have signed an entry form, must sign the appropriate Passenger in Vehicle Indemnity Form.
3. **Open Class, M1, M2 Drivers must wear driving suits in accordance with CAMS Manual of Motor Sport**, Schedule D - Apparel Clause 3 - Clothing (i) Races. All other drivers and all passengers must wear neck to ankle and neck to wrist non-flammable clothing. PCV strongly recommend all participants to wear Driving Suits. Helmets worn by drivers & all passengers must carry a standard as listed in Schedule D of the 2006 CAMS Manual.
4. All vehicles must comply with the Speed Event Standing Regulations and be fitted with all appropriate safety equipment, including seats and harnesses, which must be worn at all times by the passenger while in the car.
5. The vehicle is driven by a person holding both a CAMS and Civil drivers licence.
6. Persons under the age of 18 years may be passengers only at the discretion of the Clerk of Course. Persons under the age of 14 years may not be passengers in a vehicle if their parent or legal guardian is the driver of the vehicle. Persons under the age of 12 **MAY NOT BE PASSENGERS**. In all cases, for passengers under the age of 18, a parent or legal guardian must sign the appropriate disclaimer.
7. No competition driving may take place. The vehicle **must** be kept to significantly **less** than competition speeds.
8. All other relevant requirements of the NCR are complied with (eg track is operated in compliance with CAMS requirements, the vehicle is scrutineered etc.)
9. Personal Accident Insurance is **not** available for passengers.
10. **DISCLAIMER**
A disclaimer will need to be signed on the day. This disclaimer covers all passenger in vehicle activity, whether it be a promotional day, gift or prize.

With regard to warnings.

A verbal warning must be given at the time the indemnity is signed.

The organiser should ensure that they :-

- verbally advise the passenger that accidents can and often do happen and that motor sport is dangerous; and
- obtain from the participants a verbal acknowledgement:
 - ◊ that accidents may happen;
 - ◊ the possible extent of injuries and that they appreciate the likelihood and nature of these injuries.
- Get the participant to complete the Disclaimer.
