Terry Ward and I have now surveyed the planned 2008 Trip in full. I must say I am very impressed with the roads, scenery and the restaurants, and I am sure they will surpass the 2007 trip. Once again the 4 day event will be restricted to a max 15 cars given accommodation issues etc...

### **COST**

**A cost of \$ 1015.00 per couple per car.**

This includes 3 nights accommodation at Bright, Eden & Tumbarumba.

A continental breakfast, Dinner each night including a half bottle of white or red wine per person.

A boxed Lunch on Sunday 2 March 08.

There will be welcoming drinks at each venue.

We have **not included lunch or morning tea** in this cost for Thursday, Friday and Saturday. We suggest you bring a picnic lunch and thermos. We have surveyed some wonderful country bakeries at our suggested stops for morning tea. For the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> day there are wonderful bakeries that make fresh sandwiches and rolls at Bright & Eden for your picnic lunch.

### **PAYMENT**

For those of you who expressed interest we are now accepting Bookings on a first in basis and payment to PCV is required with registration. There are two payment options:

- Non-Refundable deposit of \$100 per car, with the balance due by 31<sup>st</sup> January 2008.
- Full payment now.

### **LONG WEEKEND 28, 29 February, 1 & 2 March 08**

This would be a Thurs/ Fri/Sat/Sun event

#### **DAY 1 Thursday 28 February 08**

We would travel through Warburton, Cambarville, and Marysville. Morning tea at Alexandra. Picnic lunch will be at Mansfield. Leave for a run to King Valley, Oxley, Myrtleford, Rosewhite, and Tawonga and over Mt. Beauty to our motel at Bright.

The motel we plan to use has secure off street parking, down a quiet side street, near the town centre. That night we would have dinner together in at "92 On Gavan" restaurant. Dinner, and wine, included in the cost.

Rough distance estimate: 450kms

### DAY 2 Friday 29 February 08

Leave Bright, travelling over the very scenic Mt Hotham, Morning tea at Omeo, then on to Tambo Crossing to Bruthen. Lunch at Bruthen Then to Nowa Nowa joining the Princes H'way and to Cann River for Afternoon Tea and to Eden. We will be staying at Twofold Bay Motor Inn with secure parking in the centre of Eden with delightful views of the bay.

Dinner together at a seafood restaurant, a short walk to the boat harbour. Dinner and wine included in the cost.

Rough distance estimate: 467.5kms

### DAY 3 Saturday 1 March 08

Depart Eden for Wolumla turn off, Candelo, Bemboka. Morning tea at Nimmitabel. Then to Cooma, Adaminaby and a wonderful run to lunch at Talbingo on the Jounama Pondage. After lunch on to Tumut, through the apple orchards around Batlow and on to Tumbarumba. You will again be delighted with the roads , scenery and the enjoyment of driving our cars.

We will be staying at a very nice motel "Tumbarumba Motel" and dining at their very attractive restaurant "Elms". The motel is a short walk to the town.

Dinner, and wine, included in the cost.

A lunch box will be provided for Sunday as most bakeries will be closed on our last day

Distance estimate: 426.7kms

### DAY 4 Sunday 2 March 08

Depart Tumbarumba for Tintaldra Morning tea at Walwa, over the Mt Granya with lunch at Tallangatta. Members can either return via Wodonga and the Hume freeway, or via Kiewa Valley, Rosewhite, Myrtleford, Milawa, Whitfield, Mansfield and Yea. We then return to Melbourne.

Rough distance estimate: 570kms

The 4 days will have a good mix of fast sections and twisty sections wit some wonderful scenery, dining and hospitality.

### **PREPARATION**

We are going to provide participants with maps with the route marked on them, plus written notes of key turning points and distances.

We are asking each car to **carry a portable UHF radio** for ease of communication.

This will be a great run...book early so as not to be disappointed.
