13 August will be a Driver Training Day, run by the Club, to meet exactly these objectives.

The format will include a classroom session run on the Thursday night at Porsche Centre Melbourne. The session (about 1.5hrs) will go thru car preparation, safety, lines, run of a sprint day and the basics of car control. This session will be run by an experienced, external, performance training instructor

On the day activities will commence at 8am on Saturday at Phillip Island International Raceway, with scrutineering followed by a short revision, track inspection and briefing then individual training sessions. Up to 45 participants will be accepted, running in 3 groups of 15 with individual coaching from experienced club members. All sessions in the morning will be coach and driver, the afternoon session will be a mix of coached and individual practice.

Participants will require a CAMS L2S Licence and a helmet. The L2S licence is available online at [http://cams.com.au/Members/Competitors/Licence\\_Types.aspx](http://cams.com.au/Members/Competitors/Licence_Types.aspx)  
The helmet must comply with AS1698 or other standards as listed in Schedule D of the CAMS Manual

### 1. Authority

- The event will be a Club **driver training** day held under the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A., the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd. (CAMS), the Speed Event Standing Regulations, the Non-Competitive Speed Event Standing Regulations (Familiarisation Session), the Passenger in Vehicle Guidelines, the 2011 P.C.V. Standing Competition Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations, and any Further Regulations which may be issued. The event will be conducted under and in accordance with the CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au)
- The event will be an untimed practice conducted at Phillip Island Grand Prix Circuit over 4.45km in an anti-clockwise direction.

### 2. Entries

- Must be lodged with the event Secretary. Faxed entries with credit card payment will be accepted to fax number 9391 5911.
- In accordance with NCR83, the competition committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without explanation.
- A maximum of 90 entries will be accepted and in order of receipt on a correctly completed entry form.
- Entry fee is as stated on the entry form
- Entries open on 30 June 2011 and close at 9:00am Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> August 2011. Refer to entry form regarding late entries.
- All competitors must have registered to get their Cars scrutinised by 08.45 hrs on the day of the sprint.
- Entry to the event is conditional upon assisting on the day as and when requested by the organisers.
- Competitors must produce their current Porsche Club Victoria membership card and current CAMS L2S licence (or superior), Logbook and Competition Record at registration.

### 3. Vehicles

- Cars presented to the scrutineer not ready for competition will be denied entry to the event.
- Logbooks (if issued) must be presented at scrutiny.
- Cars must comply with Section 6, Schedules A and B of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport & P.C.V. 2011 Competition rules.
- Tyres must be roadworthy and comply with P.C.V. 2011 competition rules.
- Open, M1 & M2 Class cars must comply with the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, Schedule E - Wheel and Tyres, Clause 3 - Wet Weather Tyres
- Competition cars may be selected for Dyno and/or Weight testing and/or Eligibility assessment under the 2011 PCV standing rules.
- Maximum Noise not to exceed 75db(A) as measured by 30-Metre drive by test on equipment provided by circuit.

### 4. Apparel

- Open 1, M1, & M2 Class competitors must wear driving suits in accordance with CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, Schedule D - Apparel Clause 3 - Clothing (i) Races. All other competitors must wear neck to ankle to wrist non-flammable clothing.
- Helmets must carry a standard as listed in Schedule D of the 2008 CAMS Manual.

### 5. Event

- Cars will be released onto the circuit alternately at 5-15 second intervals. Vehicles must run in allocated Group order. A maximum of 20 cars will be permitted on the circuit at any one time.
- Drivers are not to refuel in pit lane, starting or dummy grids
- Drivers must obey flag and board signals. The Facts to be Judged shall be in accordance with the Speed Event Standing Regulations.
- Protests, if any, must be submitted in writing to the Stewards or Clerk of Course in accordance with Part XII of the NCR.
- Results will not be posted.
- Vehicles will not be permitted on the circuit after 4.30pm and must have vacated the complex by 5.00pm.
- During driver training only entered drivers and experienced competitors will be permitted in vehicles as passengers, subject to bone-fide instructors signing the appropriate indemnity form. All occupants must have at least Level 2S licences. Vehicles are to be driven at 80% of race pace.
- The Porsche Club of Victoria reserves the right to take appropriate legal action, and to recover damages.

### 6. General

- In accordance with NCR59, the Promoter reserves the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the event at any time.
- Insurances will be provided in accordance with Appendix I of the CAMS Manual.
- During any competition, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A of the Current CAMS Manual. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the Articles of the Procedure for Alcohol Testing and CAMS Drugs in Sport Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be tested for alcohol or other drugs at any times during the event(s). This regulation serves as the required 24-hour notice to Competitors, Crew and Officials.
- Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the CAMS Manual and will not be available at the event.
