1. Authority

- * The event will be a multi-car sprint conducted at Winton Motor Raceway over the 3.00km (long) circuit in a clockwise direction.
- * The event will be a club Sprint conducted under the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Australian Auto-Sport Alliance Pty Ltd (AASA) and held under the 2021 PCV Standing Competition Rules, these Supplementary Regulations, and any further Regulations which may be issued. By entering this event, you agree to comply with all Regulations.
- * The event is open to all members of Porsche Club of Victoria holding the appropriate competition AASA Club Racing licence, or an AASA recognised equivalent standard licence (or higher) which must be presented and verified prior to the day of the event.

2. Entries

- * Entries open on publication of these Supplementary Regulations at pcv.com.au. Entries close midnight on Sunday 7 February, after which further entries may not be accepted (at the discretion of the organisers).

- * Online entry is available from the Club website pcv.com.au. Entries are only accepted where the entrant has verified that they have read and accepted the AASA Disclaimer and paid the nominated entry fee.
- * The Competition Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without explanation or if deemed appropriate.
- * The Clerk of Course may withdraw any entry on the grounds of safety, misconduct, or inappropriate behaviour.
- * Entry to the event is conditional upon assisting on the day as and when requested by the organisers.
- * Entrants must have verified their club membership card and current track licence prior to the day of the event.

3. Vehicles & Apparel

- * Cars presented to dummy grid which appear not ready for competition (including without limitation all loose objects not removed from the vehicle) will be denied entry to the event.
- * Cars must comply with PCV 2021 Standing Competition Rules.
- * Magnetic numbers must use tape to secure at least the leading and top edge.
- * Seatbelts must be fitted to the vehicle and must comply with current Australian Standards.
- * Open, Cup and Modified Class cars must comply with the AASA requirements - Wheel and Tyres, Wet Weather Tyres.
- * Competition cars may be selected for Dyno and/or Weight testing.
- * Drivers of vehicles who record more than 95dB(A) at any time shall cease on track activity and shall not resume until the Clerk of Course, in consultation with the Chief Scrutineer, is satisfied that the problem causing the excessive noise, is rectified.
- * Open, Cup, Modified and GT Class competitors must wear driving suits. All other competitors must wear neck to ankle to wrist non-flammable clothing.
- * Helmets must meet Australian Standard AS 1698 or higher (refer AASA Appendix 4).

4. Event

- * Entrants will be seeded in Groups with similar lap times with a maximum of 20 cars per Group (or such other number as Covid-19 restrictions permit).
- * Drivers must run in Group order unless otherwise instructed by an official.
- * Speed in the pit area must not exceed 10km/h.
- * Drivers are not to refuel in pit lane, starting or dummy grids or garages.
- * The Facts to be Judged shall be in accordance with the Speed Events Standing Regulations - Supersprint. The Clerk of Course shall be the judge of facts.

5. General

- * Consumption of alcohol by drivers is absolutely forbidden. Consumption of alcohol in non-public areas is forbidden until the conclusion of the meeting. PCV enforce a zero-blood alcohol limit and Random Breath Testing may occur at any time on the day. Any driver or Official found over the zero limit will be asked to leave and penalties may be applied including exclusion from other Club events.

- * Protests, if any, must be submitted in writing to the Stewards or Clerk of Course as per 2021 PCV Standing Competition Rules.
- * Vehicles will not be permitted on the circuit after 5.00pm. and must have vacated the complex by 5.30pm.

6. Covid-19 protocols

* *Government requirements*

Federal, State and Territory and Local Public Health Authority guidelines will be followed in the running of this event.

* *Monitoring*

All attendees (including Competitors, Officials, and support crew (note limit on permitted numbers) are required to preregister for the event. All are encouraged to use the COVIDSafe App. Only authorised attendees will be allowed access to the venue. No spectators will be permitted.

* *Hygiene practices*

- Appropriate signage will be placed at the venue. Reminder Public Address announcements will be made reminding participants to practice appropriate hygiene. Hand sanitisers, wipes and spray will be available.
- A Covid-19 Compliance Official will monitor practices throughout the day.
- If the Covid-19 Compliance Official forms the view that *Hygiene practices* are not safe the event may be suspended until safe *Hygiene practices* are restored.
- If the Covid-19 Compliance Official forms the view that breaches of *Hygiene practices* are occurring the event may be cancelled.

* *Venue entry and exit*

Entry and Exit to the event will be via the main entry point. A list of authorised competitors, support crew and officials will be provided to the venue. Only authorised attendees will be allowed access to the venue.

* *Social distancing*

Under no circumstances are competitors to enter the control office or another competitor's garage. All competitors, officials and volunteers must demonstrate social distancing requirements and remain minimum 1.5m apart.

* *Documentation and Licence checking*

All documentation and licence checking will be conducted remotely prior to the event. In person Licence check and registration may not be available on the day of the event.

* *Briefings/Event communication*

All pre-event briefings will be conducted online. Communication during the event will be via public address system and electronic means. Contactless Dorian pick up will be available. If required, Officials will be positioned behind protective screens.

- * *Scrutiny*
Scrutiny arrangements will comply with appropriate Covid-19 non-contact protocols. Details will be provided.
- * *Equipment*
Any equipment will be appropriately cleaned prior to use. Appropriate signage regarding hygiene practices and social distancing will be displayed.
- * *Paddock*
All competitors, officials and volunteers must demonstrate social distancing requirements and remain 1.5m apart. When using public amenities, they must comply with the maximum person allowance as displayed.
- * *Judicial matters*
If required Clerk of Course or Assistant Clerk of Course and Steward to meet with competitor outside at base of control tower. 1.5m social distancing to be maintained. No competitors are permitted to enter the control tower.
- * *Medics and Safety/Recovery*
Maximum 2 per vehicle, Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to be used.
- * *Trackside Officials*
 - Flag marshals – maximum 2 per post maintaining minimum 1.5m distance.
 - Dummy Grid - all drivers to remain in car.
 - No persons apart from designated Officials allowed on the dummy grid area.
 - PPE to be used and 1.5m social distancing to be maintained.
- * *Competitors and Team personnel*
No passenger rides will be allowed. Nominated (and registered) support crew (maximum one (1) per car) must stay within allotted space. Minimum 1.5m social distancing to be maintained.
- * *Race Control/Tower*
The following officials **only** will have access to the control tower: Clerk of Course, Assistant Clerk of Course, Steward. All officials to be seated min 1.5m apart. Two (2) Timing staff to be in separate area with 1.5m spacing. Signage at door to confirm maximum number of people allowed to be displayed.
- * *Entries*
Entries will close earlier than usual, on Sunday 7 February 2021, after which further entries may not be accepted (at the discretion of the organisers).
