Hire cars

The tour includes the hire of quality convertible sports cars for the drive. The standard cars will be the likes of Mercedes-Benz SLK or BMW Z4, with upgrade options available at extra cost to vehicles such as Porches, Ferraris and Maseratis. For those who prefer a larger car or hardtop, there are no-cost options.



Track days

Our schedule allows for two days at the famous Nurburgring circuit.

At this stage the calendar for 2011 has not been determined so availability of the circuit is still an unknown. Therefore two days have been planned in the tour schedule.

For those for whom one day is enough, other great visits nearby can be made, such as to the Spa Francorchamps circuit in Belgium, less than 100km away.

Many different options of rides and special hire vehicles are available for this thrilling and challenging 20km circuit (these not included in tour cost). Details of options will be provided to participants.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Following are the Terms and Conditions for the **Porsche Club WA European Driving Tour 2011** set to take place in May and June 2011. By signing the application you are confirming that you have read and agree to this document.

Name: The Porsche Club WA European Driving Tour is referred to in this document as "the event".

The Organizers: The organizers are Automotive Events Management, (ABN 37051687414), in conjunction with Broadway Travel (ABN 80489937125) License Number 9TA3/4; AEM: PO Box 1222, Subiaco, Western Australia, 6008. Broadway Travel: Shop 37, 88 Broadway, Nedlands, Western Australia, 6009, Promoted by the Porsche Club Western Australia. Initial enquiries should be directed to AEM on 9271 0101 or info@classicrally.com.au.

Participants: This term refers to people who have booked to participate in the Porsche Club Driving Tour.

Dates: The Main Event will start in Paris, France on Tuesday, May 31st, concluding on Monday, June 13th, 2011.

1. DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS

The cost per person is AUD\$7,700, bookings in pairs – either twin-share or double accommodation. Singles please refer to Item 15(h). A deposit of AUD\$2500 per person is required for bookings made before March 1st 2011, with the balance due on that date. Bookings made after March 1st 2011 require payment in full. Where a deposit has been paid and the balance is not received by this date, the place may be made available to other wait-listed applicants.

Bookings will only be considered accepted on payment of the deposit or full payment as outlined herein.

Only 16 places will be available. Couples may be two single people, and different accommodation arrangements can be made, with cost differences applying. If all places are booked, any further bookings shall be placed on a waiting list in case of cancellations, and places shall be allocated in order of date of application. A late payment fee of \$500 may be charged at the discretion of the organizers.

2. CANCELLATION

As the event approaches many bookings will be made which require deposits and payments be paid on behalf of participants. Therefore a scale of refunds according to date will apply.

If cancellation is made before March 1st, 2011 a refund of 50% of deposit and 100% of balance will be made. Cancellation after that date will have refunds applicable on the following scale:

March 1 - March 31 – 70% of monies paid

April 1 - April 30 – 50% of monies paid

April 30 – May 10 – 25% of monies paid

Withdrawals from May 10 or while the event is progressing have no entitlement to refunds. Advice of cancellation must be made in writing.

3. INSURANCE

It is highly recommended that participants take out travel insurance once your booking is made.

4. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

The organizers require a health certificate from any participants 70 years old or older, and from any participant with a known medical condition. Such a certificate (or letter from your doctor) must state that the person is fit to undertake travel and activities associated with this event.

Participants are also required to advise the organizers of any change to such condition which may occur between issue of the certificate and the start of the event.

5. DOCUMENTATION

Participants are advised to familiarize themselves with visa and health requirements that may be applicable to the areas which they will be visiting, including anywhere going to and from the event. Valid passports must be held by all participants and for non-Australian passport holding participants, Australian Re-Entry permits may be required. Visa and passport requirements are not the responsibility of the organizers and we are not liable for any loss or expense due to failure of a participant to comply with regulations pertaining to these.

6. TRAVEL TO AND FROM EVENT

It is the responsibility of participants to arrange their own travel to and from the event. Participants may wish to visit other locations whilst overseas before or after the event. Guidance and bookings can be made with our **recommended travel agent** who has detailed knowledge of this event:

Details of the meeting locations will be provided to participants.

7. ITINERARY & ROADBOOK

A detailed itinerary will be supplied to participants as a part of a Roadbook. This will include information on suggested routes to drive, distances, destinations (hotels, dinner locations, etc) and points of interest en route. The instructions will be provided in an easy to follow format. The event allows time for individual diversions, however it is not the responsibility of the organizers to ensure that participants follow the advised route, go to the advised destinations and find their way, especially in cases where alternative routes are chosen by participants. Additional subjects covered in the Roadbooks will include tips on driving in Europe, currencies, language, food, etiquette, and other useful information. Roadbooks will be supplied before leaving Australia. We strongly suggest bringing your Roadbook in hand luggage should your suitcase be delayed or lost by airlines.

8. LUGGAGE

As a service to participants, the organizers will provide a vehicle in which some luggage can be carried during the tour component of the event. Participants are advised that the rental cars being used for the tour may not fit all your

luggage, and that large suitcases can be carried by the Luggage Vehicle. The limit is one large suitcase per couple. It is the responsibility of participants to ensure that their (easily identifiable) luggage being carried in the luggage vehicle is placed in it and removed from it daily – times and locations will be advised. The organizers accept no responsibility in any way for luggage carried in this vehicle. It is recommended that you take out travel insurance which covers your luggage for the entire period of your journey.

9. ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation will be arranged as a part of the package for nights in the Tour. We recommend that participants wishing to book accommodation either side of the tour dates book through Valerie Wright at Broadway Travel (for contact details, see section 6), though they may make their own arrangements. We can provide details of suggested hotels on request. Accommodation during the tour will be in good quality, minimum 3-star, mostly 4-star hotels. Accommodation costs will be paid for by the organizers but it is the responsibility of participants to pay for any other costs they incur at hotels, such as room service, laundry service, parking, etc.

10. NURBURGRING & LE MANS

Access to the Nurburgring is always changeable and the tour organizers provide no guarantee of access to the track. Corporate bookings, accidents, weather and other factors may limit access on the days we are there. Details of several options for rides and drives at the track will be provided to participants.

Tickets to the Le Mans 24-Hour race are not included. Prices of tickets vary. Ticket information and purchasing details will be supplied to participants.

11. RENTAL CARS

The rental cars to be used by participants for the tour component of the event are to be collected from and returned to the depots as specified. Specific choices of make and model are not guaranteed, with the exception of upgrade cars. Upgrade options can be advised on contacting the organizers. Upgrade bookings are subject to availability and at the additional cost to participants dependent on vehicle choice. Any extra costs such as extended rental periods, additional insurance, etc, will be at the expense of participants. Details of rental agreements, separate to these terms and conditions, will be provided to participants. Rental cars may not be used at the Nurburgring. Participants are reminded to bring their valid drivers' licenses. International drivers' licenses are not required.

12. MEALS

Breakfasts are included with accommodation. Dinners together on selected nights will be at locations nominated in the Roadbook. In most cases a meeting time will be scheduled at our hotels, from where we can walk to dinner. Costs of dinner food and drinks are included in the package. All locations have meal options suitable for vegetarians. The nights of these group dinners will be advised to participants. Lunches are at the expense of participants at locations of their choice.

It is advised that participants should be aware of strict drink driving laws in the countries we are driving through. Most dinner locations are planned

to be in close proximity to accommodation so that walking to and from dinner is possible. .../2

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13. VARIATIONS

The organizers reserve the rights to vary the package from descriptions given. Improvements, additions, deletions, adjustments and changes may occur for which the organizers reserve the right and can not be held liable for any loss or expense due to changes.

14. INDEMNITY

By signing the application, participants agree to indemnify the organizers, their contractors, agents, suppliers and other associated parties from any liability whatsoever for any acts, omissions or default, whether negligent or otherwise in provision of services or products in connection with the event. The organizers, their contractors, agents, suppliers and other associated parties do not accept liability in contract or in tort for any accident, injury, damage, loss, delay, irregularity, additional expenses or inconvenience caused directly or indirectly by any act, event, representation or publication.

15. FURTHER CONDITIONS & DETAILS

a. The organizers believe the content of publicity material to be true at the time of publication but makes no express or implied agreement, representations or warranty to that effect or in relation to any of the contents of the material.

b. The organizers shall be entitled to cancel the event at any time either prior to or during the event by reason of occurrence of a fire, flood, earthquake, storm or tempest, interruption of transport, embargo, industrial dispute, riots, civil unrest, terrorist activity, military coup, change of government or any other act or event occurring in the country or countries on the itinerary of the event, which the organizers in their reasonable discretion decide constitutes a danger to the security and well being of participants or staff and in the event of such cancellation the organizers shall not be responsible for the refund of any deposit or other payments made by a participant on account of the event and the participant shall have no right to claim damages from the organizers.

c. The organizers reserve the right to cancel the event at any time prior to the start date if insufficient numbers of participants register for the event. In such a case full refunds of deposits and balances shall be made to participants, who shall have no right to claim damages from the organizers or their contractors, agents, suppliers and other associated parties.

d. Where a person has made a booking on behalf of another person, the parties confirm that this is done with the full knowledge and consent of such other persons and that they have the full authorization of such persons to bind them to these conditions.

e. These conditions shall be binding upon the participants as well as their heirs, executors, administrators and personal legal representatives and also upon any family member or minor on whose behalf the participant executes this

agreement and their respective heirs, executors, administrators & personal legal representatives.

f. The organizers and their contractors, agents, suppliers and other associated parties reserve the right either before or during the event to refuse to carry or accommodate any participant which it considers unsuitable by reason of physical or mental health. Any participant whose behaviour becomes unsuitable in such a manner as to be considered a risk to the smooth operation of the event, or may be considered to adversely affect the enjoyment or safety of other participants may be excluded from continuing at the discretion of the organizers. The organizers shall be under no liability to any such person/s for refund, compensation, repatriation or any other matters arising.

g. Participants agree to be bound by the terms and conditions set out by the operators of the car hire company, hotels and other contractors and suppliers for the event. The organizers shall be under no liability for any refund, compensation, repatriation or any other matters arising from the use by participants of such services and products.

h. Where individual persons wish to apply to participate, a different cost may apply depending on sharing a rental car and/or accommodation. Details should be discussed with the organizers to suit your requirements.

i. Separate parts of the event cannot be booked individually. No refund will be made on any component of the event not used and no rights to hold-over until a later date will exist.

j. For any participant under 18 years of age, signed parental or legal guardian consent must be provided in writing with the application. Age limits may apply to hire cars.

k. Participants are required to adhere to road regulations when driving in the tour section of the event and to conduct themselves sensibly at all times on roads. Any fines or other punishments from authorities are the responsibility of the participant to deal with.

l. Not included in the package are costs of any taxes applicable, taxi, bus or train fares, gratuities, laundry, meals other than those specified and other costs of a personal nature, which are to be borne by the participants.

m. There has been publicity in the media about the possible connection between Deep Vein Thrombosis (DVT) and long distance air travel. It is the responsibility of participants to ensure fitness to travel. If you have concerns about DVT, you should consult your doctor.

n. Participants acknowledge that the route instructions issued should not be relied upon exclusively in estimating the degree of severity of any hazard which might be encountered, road condition or the manner in which any section of road is driven, whether shown in the route instructions or not; and are advised to exercise normal caution in following these route instructions.

o. AEM is not licensed travel agent as its activities do not fall within the scope of the Travel Agents Act 1985 (WA). Broadway Travel is a licensed travel agent, license

number 9TA3/4, and is a member of both International Air Transport Association and the

Australian Federation of Travel Agents. Broadway Travel is also a participant in the Travel Compensation Fund.
